



TIPS FOR A PLASTIC-FREE SAFARI

WATER BOTTLES

Use a re-usable waterbottle. At Elephant's Eye, Hwange we provide guests with an aluminium waterbottle that is refilled with filtered water.

NO STRAWS

Sip your G&T, Amarula cocktail or juice without a straw. It will still taste delicious!

FOOD

At Elephant's Eye, Hwange we pack our full-day safari picnic lunches in glass containers.

PLASTIC PACKETS

Carry a big to medium size bag/backpack, this way when you buy souvenirs or other items you can refuse a plastic bag from shopkeepers.

5

PACKING

When packing, remove any items you may have bought for your trip from their plastic packaging.

6

TOILETRIES

Use bar soap instead of liquid soap. Elephant's Eye, Hwange uses non-plastic wrapped soap in the bathrooms and the shampoo and conditioner bottles are re-used and refilled.

7

Consider using investing in a electric or stainless steel razor, instead of using plastic disposable products. Avoid bringing earbuds as well.

8

COFFEE & TEA

Elephant's Eye, Hwange coffee and tea stations use glass jars with no individually wrapped items.

9

NO SWEETS

Travellers sometimes like to give sweets to rural children on safari, besides the dental damage this causes, the wrappers usually end up as litter.

10

DRINKS

Elephant's Eye, Hwange doesn't use plastic cups at the lodge or on picnic lunches.
